RE: Notice of Special District Meeting

Dear Customer:

The Board of Trustees of the Great Salt Bay Sanitary District has authorized a \$250,000 loan from the Maine Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund, of which 55% (\$137,500) is expected to be forgiven, and 45% (\$112,500) will need to be repaid. The loan will pay for additional costs of the Standpipe Road, Back Meadow Road, and Church Street Water Main Replacement Project.

A special meeting of the District will be held on September 9, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. at the District Office, 121 Piper Mill Road, Damariscotta, Maine, for the purpose of permitting the collection of testimony from the public concerning the proposed borrowing. All persons who desire to be heard on the proposed debt are invited to attend the special District meeting.

If requested by a petition of not less than 50 voters of the District or 5% of the voters, whichever is greater, filed with the Clerk of the District on or before the date of the meeting, a vote of those attending the meeting will be called to approve or disapprove the proposed borrowing. If a majority of voters present and voting disapprove of the proposed borrowing, the debt will not be incurred.
