Amendment to the Agenda Request

I'd like to request a Select Board member make a motion to amend the agenda this evening to address two rather time sensitive assessment items for approval and signature.

One being a supplemental assessment (tax warrant and tax certificate) for an omitted parcel of land from our software in the amount of \$609.60.

Another being an abatement for a parcel that has been transferred numerous times that is/was returning to Farmspace application status in the amount of \$441.60.

All three signature documents are attached to this report, and I will have a copy for you to sign at the meeting should you choose to include as part of the meeting.

Hurricane Lee

We're in regular communication with Lincoln County Emergency Management about the most recent projections on Hurricane Lee. It is not expected to make direct landfall in the U.S., but the East Coast from central Florida to Maine will see rough surf and life-threatening rip currents starting Monday and the threat will expand to the northeast and Canadian coasts by midweek. Models are favoring Lee to pass to the east of New England and run into Nova Scotia, but there is still uncertainty, especially with the storm widening in size as it accelerates north. Parts of New England including our region should experience some rain and gusty wind as Lee passes by the end of the weekend. This may cause storm surge, rip currents as well as tree damage, road washouts, and local flooding in problem spots.

Town Fee Schedule

At our August 28th meeting, we had a brief discussion on fees specifically related to the Traffic and Parking Ordinance but also in general. I have not been able to find Select Board votes taken on previous fees, so we will look to bring a comprehensive list of all Town determined fees to the September 25th meeting for your review and consideration.

Town Clerk Interviews

We've wrapped up the interview process and pending reference checks will hopefully be making an offer this week for Select Board confirmation of appointment at the September 25th meeting.
